

ASAP/Forestville Union School District General Rules and Conduct

We are a team and must work together to be Safe, Respectful, and Responsible!

1. Wash your hands before and after eating and after using the bathroom.
2. After eating, please clean up, sweep, dispose of the trash, and place unopened items in the snack basket.
3. Keep your hands, feet, and all other body parts to yourself.
4. After you have finished using something, please return it to its correct place before getting out more materials (e.g., Legos, beads, books, cars, chairs, crafts, and snacks).
5. Please inform your teacher if there is anything that needs correction. (if a friend is crying, hurt, in danger, or breaking the rules)
6. There is no cursing, use of profanity, backtalk, arguing with staff, unkind language, or hateful comments.
7. The teacher's computer, desk drawers, snack cupboard, refrigerator, and craft cupboards are off-limits to students.
8. Please refrain from bringing toys from home. They carry germs and may get lost or stolen.
9. Cell phones and Chromebooks need to be off and put away while attending ASAP program.
10. Ten minutes, 3 days a week, for each child to use computers, with teacher permission. Violent game choices will result in a one-week suspension from computer use.
11. Please inform the teacher if you need to leave the classroom, bathroom, or be assigned a bathroom escort.
12. Please do not enter or exit the classroom until the teacher is ready; your safety is our number one priority!
13. No bouncing balls in the classroom or hallway; hold the ball, it's not polite, and it's very distracting.
14. Roughhousing and wrestling are not acceptable. Aggressive behavior or games are not permitted.

I have read and understood all the rules and will strive to follow them diligently every day, both at Forestville School and ASAP. 1) a verbal warning, 2) positive redirection, 3) discussion about behavior, 4) reflection time, and 5) making amends for mistakes. *Continuous incidents or more challenging behaviors will be documented, and corrective actions will be implemented, including but not limited to **written warnings**, as well as **meetings with parents/guardians to create a behavior plan**, if necessary, with Principal's intervention. If **unacceptable behaviors escalate daily** such as **continuous aggression** and **defiant attitudes**, and **inappropriate incidents** your child may be asked to leave the ASAP program permanently until the next school year.
