Our Morning/TK/K/After-School student programs will be open on Thursday, **August 13, 2025**. ASAP staff consists of Lead Teacher **Ms. Melissa Neigum** and assistants **Ms. Priscilla Carpenter, DeeDee Neigum, and Emma Sonke**. We are all looking forward to welcoming your children to Forestville School during our Morning, TK/K care, and After-School Programs. We will be open **in the Mornings from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m., Monday through Friday**, from school dismissal at **2:55 p.m. to 5:30 p.m.**, and early release on **Tuesdays from 2:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m.** You will find us in **rooms 23 and 24**, located at the Travis Road entrance, next to the bus circle.

Our goal is to accommodate students and families across a range of incomes. Tuition-based rates for families who qualify will be ELOP-funded for this program year. A lottery will determine enrollment. We will collect registration forms at the following locations: printed copies from the website and emailed to mneigum@forestvilleusd.org; paper copies available in the ASAP room (24); the school's welcome BBQ, August 5, 2026; and the school office, starting Monday, August 3, 2026. After reviewing all applicants, we will ensure the child-to-teacher ratio is met, then use a lottery system to ensure fairness for every student and family. You will find a **registration form, agreement, Registration fee of \$100.00, 1st month's tuition, medical form, schedule/contract, behavior contract, parent handbook, and excessive late pick-up** and other relevant information in our registration packet.
